The Regional Development Forums are organised annually by the CIMC Secretariat under the Chairmanship of the Minister for National Planning and Monitoring, Hon. Charles Abel.

The CIMC is a broad based consultative mechanism that facilitates ongoing dialogue between government, private sector and civil society to discuss pressing development issues with a view to directly influence public policy development & implementation.

The CIMC maintains its functions through various consultative processes including the staging of annual Development Forums in order to gauge views of the community at large.

Envisioning the need for Quality Leadership, the theme for this year was chosen to allow informative reflections on experiences, and generate discussions around leadership and community oversight to provide the basis improved governance on the use of public resources.

The theme provides an opportunity for the public to be made aware of the potential of community oversight to ensure resources are used for the intended purposes. Such discussions promote and enhance community participation, capturing a multi sectoral approach which is crucial to achieve broad based and inclusive development outcomes.

Key outcomes of the Regional Development Forums will be compiled by the CIMC Secretariat as a National Executive Council (NEC) submission. This will then be presented to the NEC by the CIMC Council Chairman and Minister for National Planning and Monitoring, Hon Charles Abel for its endorsement.
